










All natural water bodies display pulsing hydrological rhythms







Pulsing hydrology of Rivers










How the book on River Culture developed





Global River Culture - Lessons from the book



- Similar drivers, but different dynamics of deterioration of River Culture
- Tipping points are approaching fast
- Intergenerational and transboundary, cultural disruptions
- NO return to "good old times", but cultural use forms may receive new functions (→ translational research)
- Nature-based solutions + sustainable innovations
- River awareness helps bending the curve (local actions)
- Climate change: an efficient driver for action
- Good governance is needed for the entire river
