We work out of three river basins:

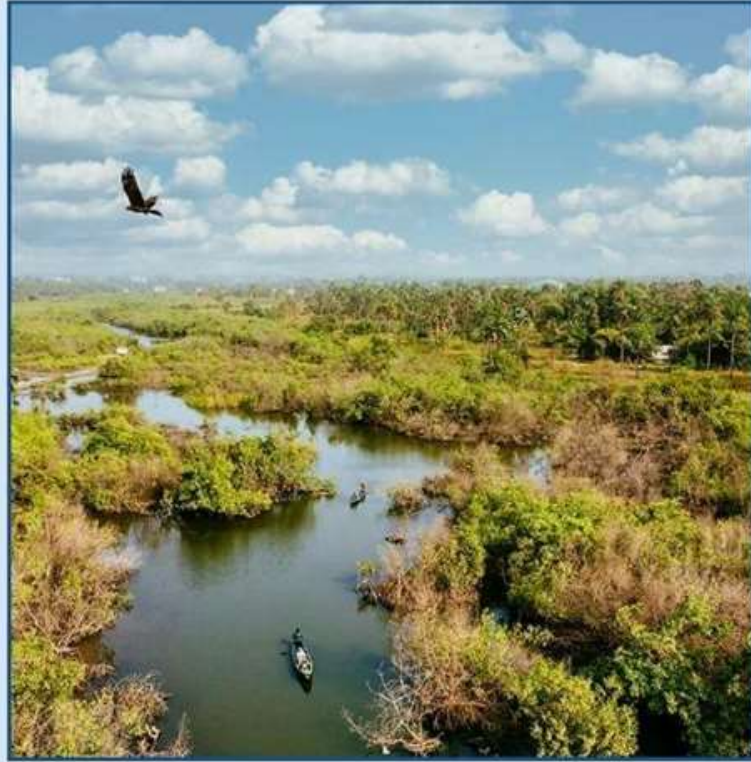
- **The Sundarbans (India)**
